

BUG Report

What is BUG?

The BUG rating is used to describe distribution and intensity of light from a luminaire. It is often used to establish performance of exterior luminaires and to provide specifications for luminaires on lighting schemes.

B (Backlight)	The light directed behind the fixture.
U (Uplight)	Any light directed upward (<i>often seen as light pollution, or sky glow</i>).
G (Glare)	The amount of light emitted from the luminaire at high angles (<i>can be seen as the amount of 'discomfort' caused by a luminaire</i>).
